Food, candy, pets, weapons, tobacco, e-cigarettes, vapes, drugs, alcohol.

Mothers and daughters can leave campgrounds together during the weekend – but only together, and they will need to sign out. You will be together and responsible for the safety of your daughter during all the activity times except for during riding lessons. Riding groups will be separated, and the riding instructor will be responsible for your daughter during that time. You will be able to go on your trail ride together.

We will assign cabins based on your requests. We will do our best to accommodate your requests. All ages may be mixed in the same bunkhouse.

- Alcohol will not be permitted during the weekend
- Cell phones may be used quietly and away from the group. They must remain in silent mode throughout the weekend.
